PROGRAM INFORMATION: The Cosmetology Program requires 1,600 clock-hours of instruction and is comprised of five levels. Levels One and Two consist of 11 units per level. Level Three consists of 10 units. Levels Four and Five consist of 9 units per level. With good attendance, the day program may be completed in approximately 1 year; the day program hours are Monday thru Friday from 7:00am - 4:30pm. The evening program may be completed in 2 ½ years; evening program hours are Monday thru Thursday from 5:00pm - 10:30pm. **There is no summer session available for the evening program.**

GETTING STARTED: FUTURE COSMETOLOGY STUDENT

Step 1: Apply online to become a Fullerton student at www.fullcoll.edu. Please call the Admissions and Records Office at (714)992-7075 with any question regarding applying to the college. Once you apply, the Admissions and Records office will email you a time and date to register for classes.

Step 2: Register for COSM 055AF Level One for either the day or evening course. Enrollment is subject to availability.

| 2. Current Kit | Module 1 - \$900.00 (To be paid before 1 st day of class) (Plus Sales Tax) Module 2 - \$925.00 (To be paid the last week of Level 1) (Plus Sales Tax) The kit is to be purchased from Western Kit Company. |
| 3. Other expenses | Expect to spend approximately \$500 for materials throughout the 1600 hour program. |
| 4. Units | \$46.00 per unit. |
| 5. Parking pass | Optional - \$40.00 per 16 week semester (\$20.00 for Summer Session) |
| 6. Health Fee | Mandatory - \$19.00 per term |
